Rationale

We believe that the wearing of a school uniform enables children to identify with their school, gives a sense of belonging, is practical and smart, reinforces a positive work ethos and reduces expenditure for parents/carers.

Aims

- All children wear the correct uniform to school
- Children feel proud to belong to the school
- Parents/carers share the expectations of the school

Guidelines

- It is expected that children wear the school uniform each day, with the appropriate footwear.
- The school website provides parents/carers with full details and prices of the uniform to be worn (see attached uniform list).
- If a child does not wear the correct uniform, a verbal or written reminder of our expectations will be communicated to the parents/carers.
- PE kit should be kept in school all week in a named bag and only taken home at weekends for washing.
- Parents are asked to clearly label every item of school clothing with their child's name (including all footwear).
- The children are responsible for taking care of their own items of uniform.
- There are baskets for lost property located in each building.
- If there is any reason why a child cannot wear our uniform or requires special dispensation (eg health or religious grounds) then the governors will consider sympathetically any such request from a parent/carer.

Uniform List for Surlingham Primary

Winter Uniform

- Red/ white polo shirt
- School sweatshirt or sweat-cardigan with logo
- Grey or black skirt, pinafore dress or trousers
- Sensible black shoes/black trainer style shoes/black leather style boots. The same footwear should not be used inside and out during wintry weather. Children who are keen on playing football on the field will need to change into trainers.
- Plain blue, black, grey tights or socks.

Additional Summer Uniform

- Red and White checked dress
- Grey or black shorts
- Sensible black shoes/black trainer style shoes. No open toe sandals or croc style shoes.
- Plain red, black, grey or white socks.

P.E. Uniform

- Red School t-shirt with logo
- Black football shorts (no sport logos)
- Spare plain red, black, grey or white socks.
- Black plimsolls (preferably slip-on type)
- Trainers/football boots (for outside sessions)
- Plain black tracksuit bottoms (for outdoor games in cold weather)
- P.E. bag

Additional School Uniform

- Red school fleece or shower-proof reversible jacket
- Red ski-style hat with logo
- Red sun hat (baseball or legionnaire style)
- **Federation Hooded Sweatshirt (purple)**

Hair and Jewellery

- Hair dyes, extreme haircuts and excessive/over flamboyant hairstyles or accessories are not acceptable.
- Hair accessories: red, white, black or a mix to match the uniform.
- If the hair is longer than shoulder length it should be tied back.
- Jewellery: watch only on wrist. For pierced ears, simple studs only may be worn.

We ask parents not to send pupils to school wearing jeans, tracksuits, trainers, necklaces, bracelets, tattoos, nail varnish. (PE kit may be worn to school if PE is in the morning and children can change into school uniform later.)
